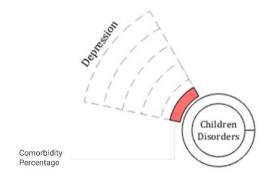
Description




Medication Recommendation
